## *The Black Boy Golf Society*

*Please see below some new/existing rules that have been put into place, following the most recent committee meeting held Monday 30<sup>th</sup> January 2017.*

- **SCORE CARDS** - Each player should mark the score and sign to approve the scorecard for ONE player in the four ball, there will be no tolerance for multiple scores on one card. If you are unsure on card scoring, please see a member of the committee for some guidance. Incorrect score cards will not be accepted.
- **BUGGIES** – If you require buggies etc. you must book your own buggy/cart/trolley, we will not pair players to share buggies.
- **SIGN UP SHEET** – You will need to write your own name on the board, please do not ask a committee member to do this for you. If your name is on the list, you are liable to pay.
- **PLAY ON DAY** –
  - ***FOUR BALLS*** – will be picked at random (except the BBGS Match-Play)
  - ***SLOW PLAY*** – 2 points per score will be deducted from each player for four ball being 15 minutes behind four ball in front, it is your duty as a player to maintain pace of play. (Allowances will be made for Match Play Competition)
  - ***MATCHPLAY FINAL*** – There will be at least one committee member acting as a referee.
  - ***GIMMIES*** – no gimmies are tolerated in a BBGS Stableford Competitions.
  - ***DISPUTE(S)*** – if there is any disputes or issues regarding a score, please correct this before leaving the course, as the scorecard marker you are responsible for the scoring of fellow player. Under no circumstances should this be aired when we return to the Black Boy for the presentations, if there are any issues please speak to the committee.
- **REPRESENTING THE BLACK BOY GOLF SOCIETY**
  - ***ATTIRE*** – Golfers are asked that you wear at least one item of BBGS clothing. We ask that as a gesture of goodwill that you donate £2.00 if not.
  - ***ETIQUETTE*** – Any person or player who uses obscene language on the course or golf club grounds that could be seen as upsetting or distressing to any other will be fined £10.00 for charity. Likewise, anyone caught throwing clubs or kicking trolleys/bags will also be fined £10.00. this money will be made payable to the charity. – Continual offenders may be asked to leave the society.
